





Dr. Raju Saha visits Chittagong Division on a Special Occasion Cheebar Daan, 16 October 2024 where Chittagong Chief Coordinator Ven Bijoyananda Bhikkhu was the prominent figure receiving us with respect and kindness.

Cheebar Daan , a religious rite and festival of Buddhism , is usually celebrated at any convenient time within a month of Pravarana Purnima (Autumn Purnima or the full moon of the Ashwin month) according to the Bengali lunar calendar. In this event, Buddhist monks are given special clothes called tricheebra . Devotees in the hope of merit like this every year donate cheebra and other accessories to the monks. A tricheebar is a four-part garment, consisting of a doajik , an undergarment, a chibeer and a girdle. Buddhist monks are allowed to wear this dress. These robes are given to Buddhist monks at a certain time each year, usually beginning on the Asadhi Purnima. In preparation for making this garment, cotton seeds are first spun, then cotton is collected, yarn is spun from it, the yarn is dyed with dyes made from tree bark or fruits, and finally various rituals and religious practices- This tri-chibar is made in just 24 hours, within a day, according to the law. Bain or bamboo frames are used to weave these clothes . Four people weave cloth together in such a bain. Thus, after 24 hours, those holy cheebras are handed over to the Buddhist monks through strict religious ceremonies. It is mentioned in the Buddhist scriptures that physical, verbal and mental efforts are more fruitful if given this way. Donating the hard-earned chibars to Buddhist monks in this way is nothing more than an unrequited act of charity and Buddhists believe that such an event will help spread the message of peace in society.
